#### KINDNESS AND JUSTICE ASSEMBLY PROGRAM

1. Welcome (Brad Pollack, principal).
2. Fassett Band: *Martin Luther King March* by Nicholas Forte.
3. Introduce and show clip of King’s *I Have a Dream* speech.
4. *I Have a Dream* — song sung by fourth and fifth graders.
5. Pre-K: recitation of a poem.
6. Kindergarten: art project.
7. Grade 1: *If You’re Friendly*, song and poem.
8. *Sing about Martin* — echo song with Pre-K, Kindergarten and Grade 1.
9. Grade 2: facts about Dr. King and a chant.
10. *Ev’rybody Ought to Know* — echo song with all students.
11. Grade 3: an acrostic poem.
12. Grade 4: *He Had a Dream* — a choral reading.
13. *He Had a Dream* — all students sing.
14. Grade 5: student reports on classroom projects.
15. *Alabama Mississippi* — a game song by King and Bessie Jones. Individual classes form circles throughout the cafeteria.
16. Dismiss (Brad Pollack).
