Elmira City School District School Board Election and Budget Vote May 15, 2018

March 5, 2018 –

Elmira City School District residents interested in seeking a seat on the Board of Education may pick up information packets and nominating petitions from the District Clerk, at the Elmira City School District Board of Education Administration Offices, 951 Hoffman St., Elmira, New York, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. beginning March 5, 2018.

Three (3) seats on the Board of Education are to be filled at the Annual Budget Vote and School Board Election to be held on May 15, 2018. The three (3) candidates receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to three-year terms commencing July 1, 2018 and expiring June 30, 2021, to fill vacancies created by the expiration on June 30, 2018 of the terms of current Board members Scott Moore, Randy Reid, and Mary Tucker.

Nominating petitions must be signed by at least one hundred (100) qualified voters of the District and must be filed in the office of the District Clerk, no later 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 25, 2018. Candidates will draw for position on the ballot Thursday, April 26, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. at the Administration Offices, 951 Hoffman Street.
