Federally insured by NCUA. Membership eligibility required. All accounts are verified through ChexSystems. Federal law requires all financial institutions to obtain, verify, and record information that identifies each person who opens an account. When you open an account, CCU will ask for your name, street address, mailing address (if different), date of birth, and other information that will allow us to identify you. We will ask to see your valid driver's license or school ID, so please bring this with you to open a new account.
