REVENUES

School Districts receive money from several sources. These sources are:

- STATE AID The budget is based on the State's 2019-20 budget. State aid for the 2019-20 budget year is expected to be \$1,011,698 more when compared to the 2018-19 budget.
- OTHER INCOME Any income received by the School District other than State Aid, Fund Balance or Tax Levy is included under this heading. Examples of other income would be; BOCES revenue, interest earnings, sales of property and equipment, refunds of prior year's expenses, gifts, rentals, fees, tuition, and Medicaid reimbursements.
 - 3. **<u>RESERVES</u>** The District maintains Reserve Funds established in accordance with guidelines established by the Comptroller of the State of New York.
 - 4. **<u>FUND BALANCE</u>** Funds which are budgeted but unexpended at the end of a budget year, and revenues which are realized in excess of those budgeted for the year, are available at the end of one fiscal year to be carried forward as fund balance.
 - 5. <u>TAX LEVY</u> This is the amount to be raised through local property taxes. The Board of Education desires to keep any increase in the levy as low as possible. For the 2019-20 school year, there will be a 2% increase to the tax levy set by the Board of Education in September 2019 for the 2019-20 school year.



SUMMARY 2019-20 GENERAL FUND REVENUES

The two main sources of revenue are the local tax levy and aid from the State of New York. For a number of years, the State has provided about 71 percent of the total district revenues. This year the estimated amount of aid totals \$92,123,642. This means that the local taxpayer will be paying approximately 26 percent of the district expense, while the State's contribution is 71 percent. Other local projected revenues of \$4,193,566 will also be committed to fund the new budget. This other revenue and fund balance represents 3.0 percent of the budget.



Proposition #1:

APPROVAL OF BUDGET

Shall the following resolution be adopted?

RESOLVED, that the proposed \$130,482,362 General Fund Budget of the Elmira City School District, Chemung County, New York for 2019-20 be approved in accordance with Section 2022 of the Education Law and that the balance of said budget, after applying public monies thereto, be raised by a tax upon the taxable property of said district.

Proposition #2:

APPROVAL TO ESTABLISH A GENERAL CAPITAL RESERVE FUND

Shall the following resolution be adopted?

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to address the needs raised in the building condition survey and by the District's Construction Manager and Architect in a prudent and efficient manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the District to put aside current surplus funds for future capital projects; and it is further

RESOLVED that the Board hereby directs that the following proposition be put before the voters of the District at the May 2019 election:

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to establish a capital reserve fund under the provisions of Education Law Section 3651(1) for the purpose of financing, in whole or in part, additions, alterations, renovations or other improvements to District's buildings and facilities, including the acquisition and installation of machinery, equipment, apparatus or furnishings required for the purposes of such buildings and facilities, and playgrounds, athletic fields, parking lots, roofing, sidewalks and other site improvements connected to such buildings and facilities, with the ultimate amount of such reserve fund not exceeding \$15,000,000 plus any accrued earnings on amounts deposited in such reserve fund; for a probable term of ten years; and funded by any or all of the following sources: unappropriated fund balances from the general fund, state aid related to expenditures from this capital reserve fund, interest income related to investment of monies in the fund, and any other additional monies hereafter authorized by the voters of the District?

New York State Education Law and the Commissioner's Regulations have required the attachment of the NYS School Report Card to the public school district budget proposal. Instructional Expenditures for General Education are K-12 expenditures for classroom instruction (excluding Special Education) plus a proration of building level administrative and instructional support expenditures. These expenditures include amounts for instruction of students with disabilities in a general-education setting. District expenditures, such as transportation, debt service and district-wide administration are not included.

The pupil count for General Education is K-12 average daily membership plus K-12 pupils for whom the district pays tuition to another school district. This number represents all pupils, including those classified as having disabilities and those not classified, excluding only students with disabilities placed out of district. Pupils resident in the district but attending a charter school are included. For districts in which a county jail is located, this number includes incarcerated youth to whom the district must provide an education program.

Instructional Expenditures for Special Education are K-12 expenditures for students with disabilities (including summer special education expenditures) plus a proration of building-level administrative and instructional support expenditures. District expenditures, such as transportation, debt service and district-wide administration are not included.

The pupil count for Special Education is a count of K-12 students with disabilities for the 2016-17 school year plus students for whom the district receives tuition from another district plus students for whom the district pays tuition to another district. Students attending the State schools at Rome and Batavia, private placements and out-of-state placements are included.

Instructional Expenditures Per Pupil is the simple arithmetic ratio of Instructional Expenditures to Pupils. The total cost of instruction for students with disabilities may include both general- and special-education expenditures. Special-education services provided in the generaleducation classroom may benefit students not classified as having disabilities.

Total Expenditures Per Pupil is the simple arithmetic ratio of Total Expenditures to Pupils. Total Expenditures include district expenditures for classroom instruction, as well as expenditures for transportation, debt service, community service and district-wide administration that are not included in the Instructional Expenditure values for General Education and Special Education. As such, the sum of General Education and Special Education Instructional Expenditures does not equal the Total Expenditures.

The numbers used to compute the statistics on this page were collected on the State Aid Form A, the State Aid Form F, the School District Annual Financial Report (ST-3), and from the Student Information Repository System (SIRS).



GRADE 3 ELA RESULTS






GRADES 4 & 8 SCIENCE SUMMARY RESULTS (2017-18)

NEW YORK STATE ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE ACHIEVEMENT TEST (2017-18)

New York State English as a Second Language Achievement Tests (NYSESLAT) are administered in grades K through 12 to all English Language Learners (ELLs). ELLs are students who, by reason of foreign birth or ancestry, speak or understand a language other than English and speak or understand little or no English, and require support to become proficient in English and are identified pursuant to Section 154.3 of Commissioner's Regulations.

The recently approved regulations recognize the importance of engaging students' interests in rigorous and relevant academic programs in the Arts; Languages other than English (LOTE)/Biliteracy; Career and Technical Education (CTE); Humanities; Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM); and Career Developmental Occupational Studies (CDOS). The revised regulation allows students to use a passing score on an approved pathway assessment or successful completion of program requirements for the CDOS credential toward meeting the assessment requirements for graduation.


